

Aeromedical Fees for Dr Neil Golder (from August 2018)

Aviation Medical examinations

EASA Class 1 - £150 (*plus VAT*)
EASA Class 2 - £133 (*plus VAT*)
LAPL - £150 (*plus VAT*)

FAA Class 1 or 2* £150 (*plus VAT*)
FAA Class 3*- £133 (*plus VAT*)

*At Oxford only

Cabin Crew - £95 (*plus VAT*)

Cabin Crew conversion from EASA Class 1 performed earlier by me - £20 (*plus VAT*) for admin fees.

Recording and reading of uncomplicated ECG - £50 (*plus VAT*).

Specialist reading of ECG by cardiologist where required by regulations -£40 (*plus VAT*).

Audiogram - £35 (*plus VAT*).

Casework - £50 (*plus VAT*) per half-hour pro-rata

(work required to resolve any medical problems preventing certificate issue, or to resolve any problems arising during the currency of the medical which have suspended it – see note below)

Note on "Casework"

In the past, for UK medical holders, casework was performed by the Civil Aviation Authority and the costs were included in the overall fees pilots paid to the CAA. With the change to EASA rules in 2011, the CAA transferred the work unfunded to AMEs, necessitating the introduction of casework fees.

How to minimise Casework fees:

Please check that any medical reports you have been asked to obtain contain all the information required (either in CAA flowcharts or spec sheets for reports given to you at the medical), and then send them to me **in one batch**. Otherwise I have to spend chargeable time either checking each of multiple batches against the regulations, or replying to you indicating what information is missing and subsequently rechecking it..
